Sacrament of Marriage: Arrangements must be made in person at least six months in advance. Please contact the Pastor to make arrangements.

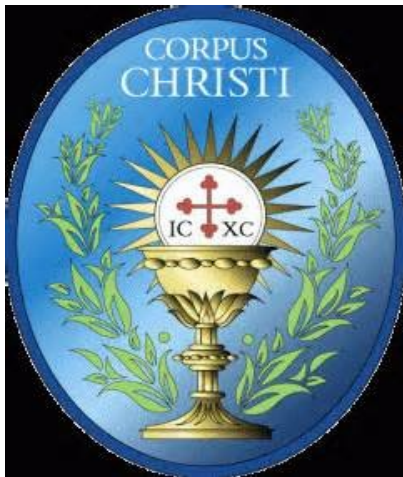

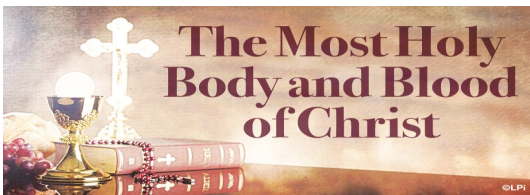

Children's Liturgy of the Word Corner



Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) - 1 Corinthians 11:23-26; Psalm 104; John 6:35, 51-56

Prayer of the Day: *God of life, help us to know that when we share our food, as you do, with all who are in need, we satisfy our hunger; when we share our drink, as you do, with all who are in need, we satisfy our thirst. We offer this prayer as we gather to eat the bread and drink the wine of your Son, Jesus, who lives with us now and forever.*

Before we talk about the readings for today, I would like you to think about a special celebration that you have. What are some of the important elements there? I am sure there are many different ones, but there is one that is the same no matter who celebrates. That element is that there is always food. Food is important in every celebration we have, and it is the same when we are at Mass. The Mass centers around the altar (a table) where priest prepares and presents the food for us. Do you know what we call this food? It starts out as bread and wine, and then with special prayers it becomes the body and blood of Jesus. Remember at the Last Supper Jesus shares the bread and wine with his apostles and it becomes his body and blood? Every time we celebrate Mass, we celebrate this over and over again. We believe that even though the bread and wine do not change physically, that IT IS the body and blood of Jesus Christ. At the Last Supper He told the apostles that ever time they share the bread and wine, He is there is a special way. The last couple of weekends, we have celebrated First Communion for our second graders who have spent the last few months learning more and more about the Eucharist and the importance of it. They were very excited to be receiving Jesus for the very first time, so let us all remember our excitement as we celebrated our First Communion each and every time we receive the Eucharist now. Remember also, that each time we receive Communion, we say that **we believe in Jesus, and we believe that He gives us life and that He will give us life forever.**
