

Father Jim's Thoughts for the week ...



When I am feeling tension or lack of focus in my prayer, especially if this is persisting for days, I ask myself these 4 questions... I call them my re-calibration questions. It is very easy to get misaligned in our spiritual life especially if we are busy! If I find that may answer is "yes" to any of them, I know I need to re-adjust my time in prayer and make some corrections.

1. Have a lightened up too much on a good thing I had been doing? (Have I let a good practice slip)

Solution: Take this to prayer and re-engage that good habit!

2. Am I fast-forwarding my day? (Mentally rushing through my day and also my prayer time)

Solution: Re-anchor into the present moments of the day.

3. Am I making my own rewards? (Focused too much on what earthly joy I can earn or purchase rather than waiting for God to provide spiritual joy)

Solution: Do a "no spend day"; plan ahead and take a day in which you don't spend any money or browse for any shopping items online and spend some more time in prayer instead.

4. Am I overdoing one of the things in my day while letting the other things diminish in value? (Example.. Too much reading and not enough prayerful contemplation)

Solution: Re-adjust you plan for the day so that things are more equally in balance.
