

Sacrament of Marriage: Arrangements must be made in person at least six months in advance. Please contact the Pastor to make arrangements.

Parish Registration/New Members: If you are new in the parish, we welcome you and invite you to complete a confidential census form to complete your membership. Parish membership is required to be a sponsor, to get married in the parish, or to have a child baptized.

I pray now in this way...

I now name people in my life who simply need fed with the Lord's Manna/nourishment, healing, or mercy for the Souls of people who have died.
