Children's Liturgy of the Word Corner



Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time – 1Kings 19:9a, 11-13a; Psalm 40; Matthew 14:22-23

Prayer of the Day: Lord, you are the God of power and gentleness. Open our eyes to find you in the ordinary things of life: in the love of our parents, in the happiness of friends, in the goodness of this world in which we live. And when things do not go so well, may we believe that you are with us always to support and care for us. We pray for this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

In both of today's readings, we find Jesus in the quiet after the storm. How many of us have storms (or troubles) in our lives? Do we turn to Jesus in those times? I know I do. We get so upset about something that sometimes we just don't know which way to turn. That is exactly when we should turn to Jesus. Look at Matthew's reading. It starts with Jesus talking with the crowd and feeding them and night was coming so Jesus went to the mountain to pray. His disciples were in the middle of the lake and the storm was tossing the boat. They were very frightened, and so when Jesus started to cross the water to them they became even more afraid. Jesus told them to calm down and even asked Peter to join him on the water. Peter started out okay and then became frightened that he might sink. Jesus grabs his hand to remind Peter that Jesus is always there to help us when we need him. The others in the boat saw this and they also realized that Jesus is always there for us when we need him. Ask for His help and you will receive it.
