


Examples: The Glorious Mysteries:

- 2. *The Ascension:* I pray this decade for _____, who is in need of hope in his life; that the Lord's ascension into heaven may grant his heart renewed faith.
- 3. The Decent of the Holy Spirit: I pray this decade for _____, who is in need of guidance in her life, to be led by the Holy Spirit to discern God's Will.
- 4. **The Assumption of Mary:** I pray this decade for ______, who is in need of clarity in her life, that the Blessed Mother Mary will guide her to the light of her son, our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 5. The Coronation of the Blessed Virgin Mary: I pray for ______, who is in a position of power and leadership, that he will be converted to recognizing the Lord's call to remain humble on earth so as to experience reward in everlasting life in God's kingdom.

Children's Liturgy of the Word Corner



Transfiguration of the Lord - 2 Peter 1:16-19; 2 Peter 1:17; Matthew 17:1-9

Prayer of the Day: O God in heaven, you have given us the greatest gift of all. You sent Jesus to live with us and to show us how to love. We will listen, God. We will do our best for you and your Son, Jesus, our Lord.

Peter writes the first reading and Matthew the gospel, but both reflect on the time when Jesus was on the mountain with Peter, James and John and his appearance changed. Both instances refer to the fact that Jesus was transformed. One refers to it as the "majesty of Jesus", and the other says "his face changed and shone like the sun, his clothes became white as light". Yes, Jesus was human, but he was also divine. This Sunday's readings emphasize the divine and gives us a preview of what Jesus would be like after his Resurrection. While this was going on, a voice from the cloud says, "This is my Son whom I love very much. Listen to him." We are still called to listen to Jesus even today. But, how do we do that since we are not on that mountain with him? ...in the Bible....parents and others who teach....even in the good thoughts we have that tell us to do the right thing.
