

Cultivate the Garden Within: Capital Improvements

Your contributions to our parish help maintain the facility, making it the center of prayer in our community.

Over the last few years, we have completed many maintenance and improvement projects. Our Buildings and Grounds Committee continually addresses the important needs we have and works with the resources we have available to best protect the buildings that are entrusted to our care.

The church in Clymer received a new roof, at no cost to the parish, with the assistance of our Diocesan facilities department. The damage was caused by weather issues and determined to be covered under Diocesan insurance.

Our administration center received muchneeded roof repairs, thanks to a generous parishioner and a portion of our Diocesan Lenten Appeal returns. This fixed major leaking issues in our building. New tiles were installed and the walls painted to repair damage caused by this ongoing leaking.

The social hall is receiving new lights to fix all of the fixtures that were inoperable.

The church in Heilwood received a new state-of-the-art digital control panel for our church bells in 2019 and many other maintenance improvements since.

At the church in Ernest, the gazebo was remodeled, and the hall was freshly painted and cleaned by the prayer area by the Sacred Heart statue downstairs.

The church in Glen Campbell received a new state-of-the-art parking lot in 2019, thanks to a very generous parishioner!

The church and rectory in Rossiter received new electric service panels and a transformer to fix an electrical concern.

Our beloved Saint Patrick Church in Cameron's Bottom received a new roof in 2020 and continuing maintenance and care.

These are just some of many things we have done to care for our buildings. All of our church sites are continually evaluated and tended to with the resources we have. We are also working to provide a detailed list of all improvements we have made in the past three or more years to be available on our parish website.
