## Father Jim's Thoughts for the week ...



In this Sunday's bulletin, please take a moment to read our four year comparison financial report. Below are a few summary notes from the report.

First, our ordinary income increased by \$25,909.84 from fiscal year 2021/2022 to 2022/2023! Your generosity has helped us to maintain our budget, remain debt free and keep up with all of the demands we encounter! Thank you!

Second, under extraordinary income, we received 2 bequests totaling \$63,043.06 in fiscal year 2021/2022. We also received a payment of \$90,000 for an easement at our Cameron's Bottom property in fiscal year 2022/2023 where First Energy's powerlines travel through the property. This was for upgrades to the powerlines planned for 2025. These special items certainly increased our total income over the last two years and directly increased our Catholic Institute savings!

Third, in the bottom right corner marked by a purple highlight block, you will see our funds that are restricted reserves for specific projects noted over the 4 years. Examples include: our sign project, (completed in early 2021) window and wall projects in Glen Campbell Church, and the project reserve blue envelope funds (project funds) highlighted below the stewardship of treasure section in this bulletin.

I want to thank all of you deeply for your generosity and care for our Parish and specifically note that it is with your love and care that we have been able to grow into a healthy, financially stable parish over the years. Thank you so much for your support of our Parish. We couldn't do our projects, maintenance and ministry without your generosity! If you have any questions, we welcome you to call and we would be happy to explain any item or items on our report in further detail.

# REPORT NOTES:

Our parish has two accounts with the Catholic Institute (CI) in Greensburg in addition to our general operating account that this report outlines. section above. The balances in the Cl accounts are listed in the PARISH RESERVES

A majority of the cash balance on hand is being held for specific projects (i.e. project fund(see below), wall funds). Notably, \$29,209 of the project fund is in the CI. The rest is part of the cash balance on hand.

The project fund collection provides a way for parishioners to designate funds for use in a specific site. The project fund grows both with contributions made using the blue envelope, but also through your assessment free contributions to the DLA. The project fund balances at the end of the 2022-2023 FY appear in the Stewardship of Treasure section of today's bulletin.

\*\* FY 2022-2023 includes a one-time receipt of \$90,000 for Transmission Line Right-of-way at Cameron's Bottom.
