

Father Jim's Thoughts for the week ...



Did you know that we all have a disordered will that competes with the promptings of the Holy Spirit in our day? Have you ever wondered why you feel tense when contemplating what the Lord is calling you to do in your day or even when it is time to enter into prayer?

There is a Scripture passage in which the Lord Jesus speaks to this reality.

John 6:37-40

"Everything that the Father gives me will come to me, and I will not reject anyone who comes to me, because I came down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me."

The Lord Jesus Is God, so why does he say, "not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me?"

I believe the Lord is speaking here about the tension of a human will clashing against Gods perfect Will. The Lord Jesus is God and was certainly free from sin (He is the second person of the Trinity) Yet, He did take on true human flesh becoming fully human and fully divine. So the Lord would have been familiar with this tension we experience.

So what do I do about this tension? (Here are 3 pro tips)

- 1. Don't try to avoid it: Let the tension become familiar to you in order to grow from there.
- 2. **Practice restraint**: Make sure you chose something in your day that is *earthly comfort* to restrain from. (Excess of food, TV, Media etc)
- 3. **Practice Engagement:** In addition to prayer, try to read 3 pages of something everyday about your faith (Scripture, a book about Scripture, a spiritual book, etc.) In this exercise try to find just one thing (only 1 thing) you didn't know before. Learning about God is a form of prayer!



Dear parishioners of The Church of the Resurrection,




