

Father Jim's Thoughts for the week ...



Do I need to pray every day?

James 4:8

"Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you."

What does it mean to draw near to God? It means taking time throughout the day to pray. This prayer time needs to be thought of as conversion moments. I need to recommit to trusting in the Lord every day. Why? Because I need the Lord's spiritual food to be fulfilled. The spiritual food the Lord provides is baked fresh daily (there are no leftovers). This means that I need to ask for this food by praying daily. There are lots of options for prayer. If you do not yet have a structure of prayer in place, choose something to do every day and remain faithful to the time commitment for prayer.

Examples:

- Daily Rosary
- Divine Mercy Chaplet
- The Liturgy of the Hours
- The Angelus
- Reading a few pages of the Gospels as prayer


