### Call to Candidacy

With joy and thanksgiving to God, the Diocese of Greensburg announces that Bishop Larry J. Kulick has called Mr. Kevin Richardson to be Admitted to Candidacy for Holy Orders. Archbishop Nelson J. Perez will confer the Rite of Admission to Candidacy within Mass at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 4, 2023, in the Saint Martin Chapel at Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary, Wynnwood, Pennsylvania.

On November 4, the feast of St. Charles Borromeo, I will be admitted into candidacy for Holy Orders by Archbishop Nelson J. Perez Archbishop of Philadelphia. This is a big step for me in my formation toward priesthood. This is the first minor order I will receive in seminary. During the 4 years in Theology, a seminarian receives *Candidacy*, *Lector* and *Acolyte*. He then prepares for Ordination to the Transitional diaconate, often at the end of Third Theology. Then, he prepares for Ordination to the Priesthood at the conclusion of Theological Studies and formation.

In this step in my formation, (*Candidacy*) I am officially recognized as a possible candidate for Holy Orders one day. During this time of discernment, I should have a solid validation that I am called to Priesthood. I personally can say to the Church and the faithful; "Yes, I feel called to Priesthood".

I want to thank my family for their love and support. I especially want to thank my parents, Paul and Tracy Richardson, and my sister Abigail for their constant love and support. To the many pastors who have helped me by their prayers and encouragement, especially Fr. Jim Morley. Thanks to all of you my parish family at Church of the Resurrection for your prayers and support!

To any young man discerning a call to the Vocation of Priesthood I encourage you to pray about it and discern if this is for you. We are blessed to have a Vocation Chapel close to Church of the Resurrection at St. Thomas More University Parish. This is a place where anyone can come and pray about what God is calling you to be in your life. Please be assured of my prayers for you also.

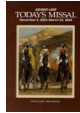
