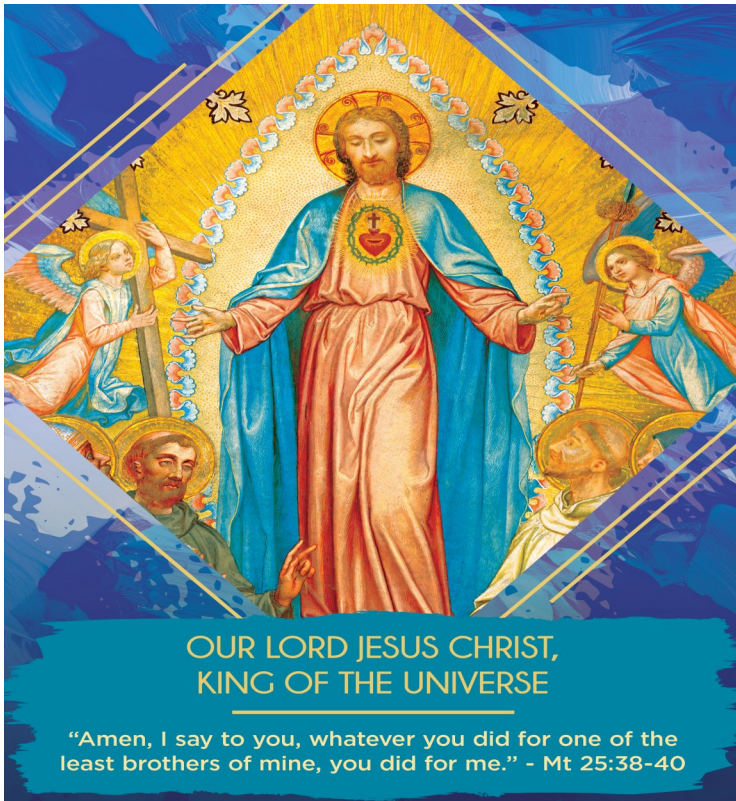

Father Jim's Thoughts for the week...



Sunday November 26th 2023 The Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Gospel: Matthew 25: 31-46 (Question: "Am I a sheep that will be placed on the right side of Jesus, or am I a goat that will be placed on his left?")

Most of us, if not all, want to be counted as one of the Lord's sheep, not a goat. We tend to stumble in the discernment of how to do this. Matthew Kelly says in his book, *Holy Moments*; "Some moments are holy, some moments are unholy, and our choices can guide a moment in either direction." *P.19 Holy Moments; A handbook for the rest of your life.* Matthew Kelly

I want to offer 3 really important pieces of advice from my experience in how we can live more Holy Moments than unholy ones.

- 1. Look for one thing in your day (everyday) to restrain from, to tell yourself no.** Examples: I will restrain from this extra show, excess food item, consumption of media, conversation that involves gossip.
- 2. Look for one thing in your day to embrace doing that is good that you don't feel like doing.** Examples: Pray to the Lord without counting the cost or overthinking it, do a work item you are procrastinating, choose something to be disciplined with daily.
- 3. Be consistent in your prayer life.** Pray at the same times everyday as best as you can. Holy Discipline is a foundation for growth and Holy Moments. *Holy Discipline* fosters growth in the spiritual life and especially protects the soul from evil influence!
